



## REGISTRATION FORM

All information provided by the rider will be used as a registration proposal.

By registering for the Women's European Championship (hereinafter referred to as "WEC") and by signing the registration form, the rider accepts the present Terms and Conditions and authorizes Moto Club EMG Eventi and FIM Europe to use the information provided.

### Terms and conditions

Parties involved in the 2026 Women's WEC

European Motorcycling Federation (hereinafter referred to as "FIM Europe");

Moto Club EMG Eventi (hereinafter referred to as "EMG").

### Roles of the parties

EMG defines the structure and regulations of the Women's WEC and is responsible for coordination and interaction between all parties involved in the project;

FIM Europe represents the National Motorcycling Federations and determines the licensing requirements as well as the sporting and technical regulations applicable to the WEC. Riders must apply for a licence to participate in the Championship through their respective European National Motorcycling Federation;

EMG is the entity appointed by FIM to manage all operational activities, both sporting and organizational, inside and outside the events, in close collaboration with FIM.

### Participation Requirements

**Riders must be holder of a valid FIM Europe licence as mentioned in the specific validity table published by FIM Europe.** The rider must apply for the licence through her European National Motorcycling Federation, in compliance with the age limits defined in the sporting regulations. The minimum age requirement (16 years) is considered fulfilled upon completion of the calendar year;

In order to participate in the Women's WEC, the rider must equip the motorcycle with the material/kit defined by the organization, following the specific colour scheme indicated in Annex A of the technical regulations. The motorcycle must be purchased exclusively through the official Yamaha Italia dealer network;

To take part in the Women's WEC, the rider must maintain the colour scheme and graphics defined in the Women's CIV regulations throughout the entire season. In the event of an accident, the rider is required to restore the motorcycle's technical colour scheme, graphics and trim in accordance with the Women's WEC technical regulations;

Only Yamaha R7 motorcycles are admitted to the Women's WEC, including model years 2022, 2023 and 2024.

### Registration Instructions

To register for the WEC, the rider must complete the registration form clearly and legibly and send it to the following email address: [segreteria@emgeventi.it](mailto:segreteria@emgeventi.it);

For the registration to be accepted, the form must be signed by the rider; in the case of minors, it must be signed by both parents or by their legal guardians;

The registration application shall be considered valid only after payment of the required fee. All official communications will be sent exclusively via email;

Until the rider receives written confirmation of registration by email from EMG, the application shall be considered pending and not confirmed;

The WEC Championship includes a total of thirty-eight (38) riders. Wild cards may be admitted up to a maximum grid of forty (40) riders. Registration requests exceeding the maximum number permitted cannot be accepted;

All information submitted by the rider must be accurate and truthful and will be subject to verification by EMG and/or FIM. EMG and/or FIM reserve the right to exclude the rider from the Women's WEC at any time should the information provided be incomplete and/or incorrect.

## Insurance

The rider's insurance coverage is that provided by the FIM EUROPEAN Motorcycling Federations;

The compensation and liability are established by the clauses contained in the policy provided by the European Motorcycling Federation with the issuing of the license to the rider;

The pilot recognizes and accepts the risks and dangers of participating in the Women's WEC. EMG and/or its subsidiaries are excluded from any liability in the event of an accident resulting in injury, permanent disability or death.
